*4. Obligatory to take a yearly orientation for those who engage in experiments with pathogens in BSL2 and higher and/or toxins defined as specific pathogens according to the Infectious Disease Law.

*5. Obligatory to take a yearly orientation for those who engage in experiments with hazardous microbes (Level 3) and/or using living modified organisms (P3).

*6. Recommended for faculty and staff who are new comers or who have not participated in the orientation before.
