Outline	The Laboratory of Immune Regulation investigates the pathogenesis of various immune diseases, focusing on the inflammatory cytokine Interleukin-6 (IL-6). We are seeking a highly motivated individual to further advance our research on elucidating the molecular mechanisms of IL-6 signaling and its downstream signaling such as STAT family proteins in immune cells and developing technologies to control acute inflammatory responses by targeting these signaling. The successful candidate will employ multifaceted approaches, including immunological, cell biological, and molecular biological techniques, to address these research challenges.
